COURSE DESCRIPTION

"Reflexology is a sensational, dynamic, yet simple approach to glowing health. It requires no expense, no special equipment, no drugs, and no medication. Through reflex muscles you will be able to eliminate the causes and symptoms of sickness and pain from virtually every part of the body. Reflexology is simple and safe for anyone to use, anywhere, and at any time. The powerful healing forces of reflexology will make you whole: bring you renewed vigor, vitality, and beauty; and eliminate illness and pain from your life" (*Body Reflexology* by Mildred Carter and Tammy Weber).

Principles taught through The School of Natural Healing's Reflexology Program complement any health care profession including Massage Therapy, Naturopathy, Midwifery and Chiropractic care. In most states licensed massage therapists may use the title reflexologist after taking this course (state laws may vary).

The certificate awarded after completing this course does not entitle you to practice reflexology professionally, teach reflexology, or use the title reflexologist in ads or endorsements.

LEVEL 100-FAMILY HERBALIST

(Level 100 from Master Herbalist Course)

The "Family Herbalist" course addresses the fundamentals of natural health and answers the question: "What is the cause behind all major disease?"
